Ms. Stone is creating a new piece for SSBYD company dancers to be adjudicated in January and to premier at Celebration of Dance on March 11.



Eva L. Stone received a BFA in Performance and Choreography from Arizona State University. After completing a Master of Arts degree in Choreography and Choreological Studies from Trinity Laban in London, England, she formed The Stone Dance Collective, a modern dance company. Eva relocated to Seattle in 1995, re-established her company, and began an extensive teaching and lecturing career throughout the Puget Sound. She is currently on faculty at Pacific Northwest Ballet School and Spectrum Dance Theater, in addition to working as a guest instructor and commissioned choreographer with dance festivals and companies around the US.

Dress Code for Fall Classes

Female

*All female dancers levels 2-6 may wear a short skirt (for center only)

Primary 1: light yellow leotard, short yellow skirt, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in a bun Primary 2: light yellow leotard, short yellow skirt, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in a bun Primary Jazz 1 + 2 light yellow leotard, short yellow skirt, pink or tan tight or black jazz shoes or pants, black jazz shoes, hair in a bun or ponytail

Level 1: light green leotard, short green skirt, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in a bun

Level 2A: light lavender leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in a bun

Level 2B: light lavender leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in a bun

Level 3A & B: light blue leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in a bun

Levels 4AB&C: rose or black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in a bun

Level 5/6: royal blue or black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in a bun

Jazz 1-6: Leotard matching level color, pink or tan tights or black jazz shorts or pants, black jazz shoes, hair secured in ponytail or bun

Tap: Leotard or shirt, black jazz shorts or pants, black tap shoes, hair secured in ponytail or bun Contemporary: Comfortable dance clothes, socks or bare feet according to teacher, hair pulled back

Male

All levels black tights or leggings, plain white top, black ballet shoes

Jazz 1-6: black leggings, jazz pants, or jazz shorts, plain white top, black jazz shoes

Tap: shirt, black jazz shorts or pants, black tap shoes

Tap: Shirt, black jazz shorts or pants, black tap shoes, hair secured in ponytail or bun

Contemporary: Comfortable dance clothes, socks or bare feet according to teacher
